Starke County Community Foundation and Starke County Scholarship Foundation

Sheila Akers shared information about the Starke County Scholarship Foundation, of which she is the treasurer. The Foundation funds scholarships for Starke County students pursuing a four-year degree after high school. It works closely with the school counselors to encourage students to apply.

All the money donated annually is awarded as scholarships. There are also some endowed funds. Funds are solicited beginning in February and scholarships are awarded at high school Honors Programs.

Cheryl Orkis was unable to attend the meeting but contributed the following information about the Starke County Community Foundation:

Starke County Community Foundation (an affiliate member of Northern Indiana Community Foundation) was founded in 1996 with the purpose to improve the quality of life in communities, schools, churches and various organizations in the county.

The Foundation has helped provide opportunities for students in our county schools by funding many projects, field trips, and materials:

- •SCCF has presented \$110,330 in 2022 plus \$2.3 million since inception.
- •The Foundation has awarded over 650 Scholarships totaling more than \$1 million.
- •Children from 207 families were able to attend preschool with the \$162,000 provided from the Preschool Scholarship Fund.

The following grants benefit educators:

- •The Starke County Community Foundation awards up to \$1500 to each corporation in the county.
- •Maude Brown and Henry F. Schricker Endowment Grant awards one \$500 grant to provide support to all fourth grade or above regarding Indiana history and social studies.
- •Knox Class of 1970 Care Grant awards \$100 for Knox Community Schools.
- •Our Kids Excel Grant awards \$500 for North Judson San Pierre students K-12.


